Covered Activities

The Personal Accident Policy provides cover for Bodily Injury to all Insured Persons whilst participating in, including direct travel to and from, the Bridge to Brisbane event sanctioned by Events Management Queensland (EMQ).

What is a Bodily Injury?

Bodily Injury means an identifiable physical injury which is not a Pre-existing Condition, resulting solely and directly from an Accident and which occurs independently of any Sickness or any other cause, where the Bodily Injury occurs during Operative Period of Cover. It does not mean a Sickness.

General Exclusions apply, for the full list of exclusions please view the Policy Wording:

Examples of general exclusions include:

- A deliberate self-inflicted injury
- Any criminal or intentional illegal act
- Any re-occurring/pre-existing injuries of any kind
- Stress and/or anxiety related conditions

How do I make a claim

To make a claim for injury, you will need to take the following steps:

Step 1:

Obtain a claim form by contacting Howden at sportentertainment.aus@howdengroup.com.

Step 2:

Please complete the claim form. For your reference, the policy number is BAPVSY0000072600.

Step 3:

Arrange for your Doctor to complete the Medical Statement.

If possible, provide the completed Medical Statement with your claim form. If unable to obtain prior, you can submit the claim form first and forward the Medical Statement as soon as it becomes available.

Step 4:

Return the completed claim form to DWF Claims Management (Australia) Pty Ltd.
